The Church has fallen short of accomplishing God's will in the earth.

The "Pastoral-Consumer" Model has minimized the power of the Church.

The COVID crisis and the Coming Harvest mandate a major shift in Church.

II. Understanding the SG MANDATE: Kingdom Expansion Depends on Small Groups

The Biblical Foundation of Small Groups or MicroChurch

The doctrine of the priesthood of every believer. See Rev. 1:6.

The doctrine of the Body of Christ – interdependency. See 1Cor. 12, Rom. 12.

The doctrine of discipleship in spiritual family. See Matt. 28:20, Gen. 1:28.

Understanding the Large Group vs. Small Group Dichotomy

Overemphasis on "stage-centered" ministry creates a priesthood/laity divide.

Large Group Ministry is our "Tribal Gathering". Family is in the MicroChurch.

Family is where sons and daughters are raised into mature mothers and fathers.

Connection and Community – MicroChurch is family on a mission.

Equipping and Empowering – Every-member, one-another ministry.

Inspire: Small Groups Must Become Your Most Essential Ministry

Celebrate Small Groups in every communication and in Large Gatherings.

Testimonies of the fruit of Small Groups in individual lives.

Q2Q Impact: Point out: ASG's, done correctly, transform the church.

Implement: Program Follows Culture – Boot Camp and Pilot Group

MODEL IT: Model an ASG with your core team first.

MENTOR IT: Form Teams that will launch new MicroChurches.

MULTIPLY IT: 2nd Gen groups give birth to the 3rd Gen groups.
